In her labor-intensive paintings, made on a layered and sanded plaster surface and overlaid with intricate graphite patterns, Alison Hall explores ritual and repetition. She says she is inspired both by Giotto's Scrovegni Chapel, a masterpiece of the early Renaissance, and the necessity of hard work in rural Virginia, where she grew up.
